- If you are unable to spend \$60 \$75, please consider sharing the cost with another individual or family
- The requests on the angel tag are a suggestion to help you with your shopping. It is not
 necessary to purchase exactly what is listed on the tag, nor is it necessary to purchase
 everything on the list if you have reached your spending limit
- If you choose 13 17 year olds, please know that the Salvation Army does not distribute gifts, other than clothes and outdoor wear, to teenagers. Instead they give out gift cards with a total value of \$50. If you choose this age group, please enclose a gift card, in denominations of \$10, \$25 or \$50.
- Donations of gift wrap, tape, gift bags are always welcome.
